SBDM Council Summary Draft
August 4, 2008

- All members were present.
- Mr. Robinson called the meeting to order.
- Five items were added to the agenda: Girls Soccer fundraiser, Cheerleader event, Student Council fundraiser, Volleyball trip, and Band Trip. The agenda was then approved by consensus.
- There was no public comment.
- Good news report: 1. Billy Dallas commented on the air conditioning. He had attended the Freshman Orientation when there was no air. 2. Mr. Robinson reported that the Freshman Academy was very successful. The schedule had changed a bit because of the lack of air conditioning. Mr. Robinson commended the teachers for their flexibility. 3. Roger Duvall reported that Betty Witten had received the Kentucky Farm Bureau 2008 Career and Technical Education Award for Outstanding Teacher in Community Service. Betty's Family and Consumer Science classes had been involved in an international service project with the ladies sewing group at First Baptist Church. Her classes made 100 dresses to be sent to Nicaraguan children in need.
- Minutes were approved as prepared by consensus.
- Financial reports were approved as prepared by consensus.
- The DECA officers presented their program of work for 08-09. The students were commended for efforts and their involvement in many activities.
- Stephanie Priddy, soccer booster, was present to request a fundraiser. Frank Hughes BBQ is offering the boosters the opportunity to work at a booth at the Grayson County Fair for a percentage of the sales. The council approved this request by consensus.
- Cheerleader boosters were given approval by consensus for a booth at the Grayson County Fair and selling raffle tickets for Cougar purses at the fair and at regular football games.
- A request from Student Council to sell stadium blankets was approved by consensus.
- Three overnight trips for the girls volleyball team were approved by consensus: August 15 and 16, to Owensboro, September 5 and 6 to Lexington, and September 18 and 19 to Bowling Green.
- Six fundraisers for the band were approved by consensus. A request for a trip to New York City was tabled.
- Mr. Robinson gave the NCLB report. 9 of 10 of our goals were met. The goal was not in Math for the free and reduced lunch sub group.
- Career Academies were discussed. This is an item that will be included on the council agenda each month. Much work will be done on this during this school year.
- Professional Development request were approved for Mike Meredith, Sonny Prunty, and Mona Higdon.

- Billy Dallas made the motion to move to closed session to discuss personnel. Roger Duvall seconded the motion. Billy Dallas made the motion to move back into open session. Kasey Haycraft seconded the motion. Consultation was held for the filling of ESS positions and the science teacher position.
- Council members will look over the council policies before the next meeting and will start the actual policy review next month.
